

Letter from the Principal


Dear FHHS Families,

Looking back on November, I am very proud of all our winter athletic teams. Boys Soccer finished 4th in the state. Girls Soccer finished 2nd in their league and represented Friday Harbor in the state playoffs. The Football team ended their season as League Champions.
