

Holidays

The district will observe the following school holidays and will not operate on these days:

- A. Sunday;
- B. New Years’ Day (January 1) ;
- C. Martin Luther King, Jr. Day (third Monday in January) ;
- D. President’s Day (third Monday in February);
- E. Memorial Day (last Monday in May);
- F. Independence Day (July 4) ;
- G. Labor Day (first Monday in September);
- H. Veteran’s Day (November 11);
- I. Thanksgiving Day (fourth Thursday in November);
- J. The day after Thanksgiving; and
- K. Christmas Day (December 25).

Whenever any legal holiday, other than a Sunday, falls on Sunday, the following Monday will be a legal holiday, and whenever any legal holiday falls on a Saturday, the preceding Friday will be a legal holiday.

In addition to the above, the following will also be considered to be holidays: the day before Christmas (December 24), the day before New Years Day (December 31), and the last day of spring break (variable date).
