



## Google and Online Apps for Education Parent / Guardian Permission Form

**This form must be returned to school with a parent signature for a student to be granted an account to access Google Apps for Education and other online apps used in the classroom.**

As part of our continued effort to provide the most current and effective learning experiences for your child, we are building on classroom experiences using technology. Through the use of the following online platforms, we are hoping to teach the responsible use of online resources and the impact of a digital footprint, and work toward instilling a sense of digital citizenship in your child.

### Student Responsibility

Along with opportunity comes responsibility. Google Apps for Education can be accessed both in and out of school and students must follow the SJISD Acceptable Use Guidelines for technology use at all times. Students are to notify an adult immediately, if by accident, they encounter materials, information, and/or behavior, which violate rules for SJISD appropriate expectations.

### School Responsibility

Google Apps for Education student accounts created by the school district will be managed based on parent permission and requirements for use in classes. Internet safety education using Common Sense Education will be included as part of introducing web-based tools. In school, teacher supervision and school content filters are used to ensure students access the system for educational purposes.

### Parent Responsibility

Parents assume responsibility for the supervision of Internet use outside of school. Parents are encouraged to discuss family rules and expectations for using Internet-based tools.
