7.4 Class Size

The following instructional load standards are established for traditional classroom instruction:

1. Twenty-three (23) students in kindergarten; Twenty-four (24) students in grade 1; and twenty-four (24) students in elementary combination (split) classes.
2. Twenty-six (26) students in grades 2-3.
3. Twenty-nine (29) students in grades 4 –5 and thirty (30) students in grades 6-8, and thirty-two (32) students in grades 9-12.
4. One hundred sixty (160) different students per week in grades 6-12 with the exception of band and PE.
5. Applied Music classes (defined as MS and HS Band, orchestra, chorus) and PE classes are exempt from class size limits except when, in the judgment of the instructor, the size of the class jeopardizes the health or safety of students or unit members.
6. The size of the laboratory portion of classes which require such activities will be limited to the number of laboratory stations available.
7. Other mutually agreed exceptions.
8. In the event an overload described above continues for more than five student days, the employee shall be entitled to the following compensation:
Elementary specialists shall receive \$5.00/student for every class session over the standard based on class rosters for the first of each month. Elementary traditional classroom instructors shall receive \$15.00/day per student over the standard based on class rosters for the first of each month. Secondary instructors shall receive \$5.00/student/day for every class period over the standard based on class rosters for the first of each month.
